Hazardous Cargo Guidelines:

CDC: Certain Dangerous Cargo

GUIDELINES :

Apart from the Normal Hazardous Cargoes as per CFR 49 and the IMDG Code, the Department of Homeland Security has classified a Group of Hazardous Cargo as **CERTAIN DANGEROUS CARGO** that requires additional Security Measures for the Terminal. Due to this, CDS were exempted from our Port Security Plan.

Following DCD are prohibited from Entering the Terminal:

Division 1.1 ,1.2 , and 1.5 Explosives / Blasting Agents

Division 2.3 Poisonous Gas / Material Poisonous by Inhalation” and that is in a Quantity In Excess of 1 metric Ton Per Vessel. (2,200 Lbs)

Division 5.1 Oxidizing Materials for which a Permit is required under 49 CFR 176.415

Division 6.1 Poisonous material as listed in 49 CFR 172.101 that is also “Poisonous by Inhalation, as defined in 49 CFR 171.8 and that is in BULK Packaging or that is in a Quantity in excess of 20 M/Tons per Vessel when not in BULK.

CLASS 7 RADIO ACTIVE MATERIAL

Bulk Solids : Ammonium Nitrate listed as a Division 5.1 (Oxidizing) material or its Residue / Not exceeding 1,000 Lbs. or TWO CUBIT FEET.
